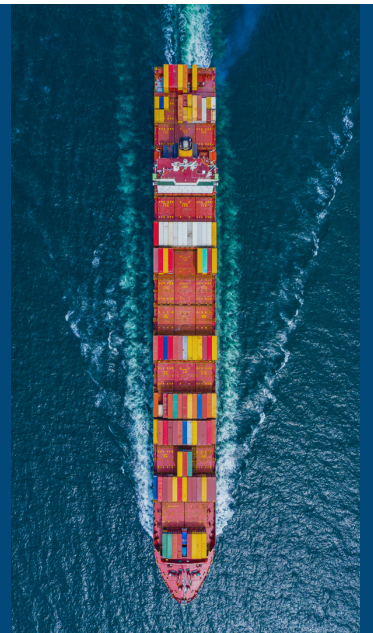


# Marine Environmental Awareness & MARPOL Compliance Training Program

## FIVE E-LEARNINGS

Individually, 25-minute, internet-based modules. Topics will include:

- Sustainable Shipping & MARPOL
- Marine Environment
- Liquid Waste
- Solid Waste
- Energy & Climate Change

## IN-PERSON WORKSHOP

Local, on-site workshop to discuss sustainability challenges, solutions, and roles and responsibilities of seafarers, maritime industry staff and leadership, regulators, and community members. A certificate of completion will be awarded to participants.

## WEBINARS

Participants will address the background of regulations that are not part of the e-learning. Topics include:

- Chemicals (Annex II & III)
- Air Pollution (Annex VI)
- Environmental Conventions
  - Antifouling
  - Invasive Species
  - Ship Recycling

## TRAIN THE TRAINER

Training will be offered to the community for several onsite individuals interested and available to continue the program in Guam. Participants will use the program materials & resources to engage with seafarers and shoreside personnel. A stipend may be available for trainers.
